Commencing at a point on the south line of said quarter section five hundred and twenty seven (527) feet east of the south west corner of said half quarter section, extending thence east twenty eight (28) feet, to the west line of West drive, said west line being, the west line of St. Pauls Cemetery, thence north along said west line one hundred and eighty six (186) feet, thence west twenty eight (28) feet, thence south one hundred and eighty six feet to the place of beginning.

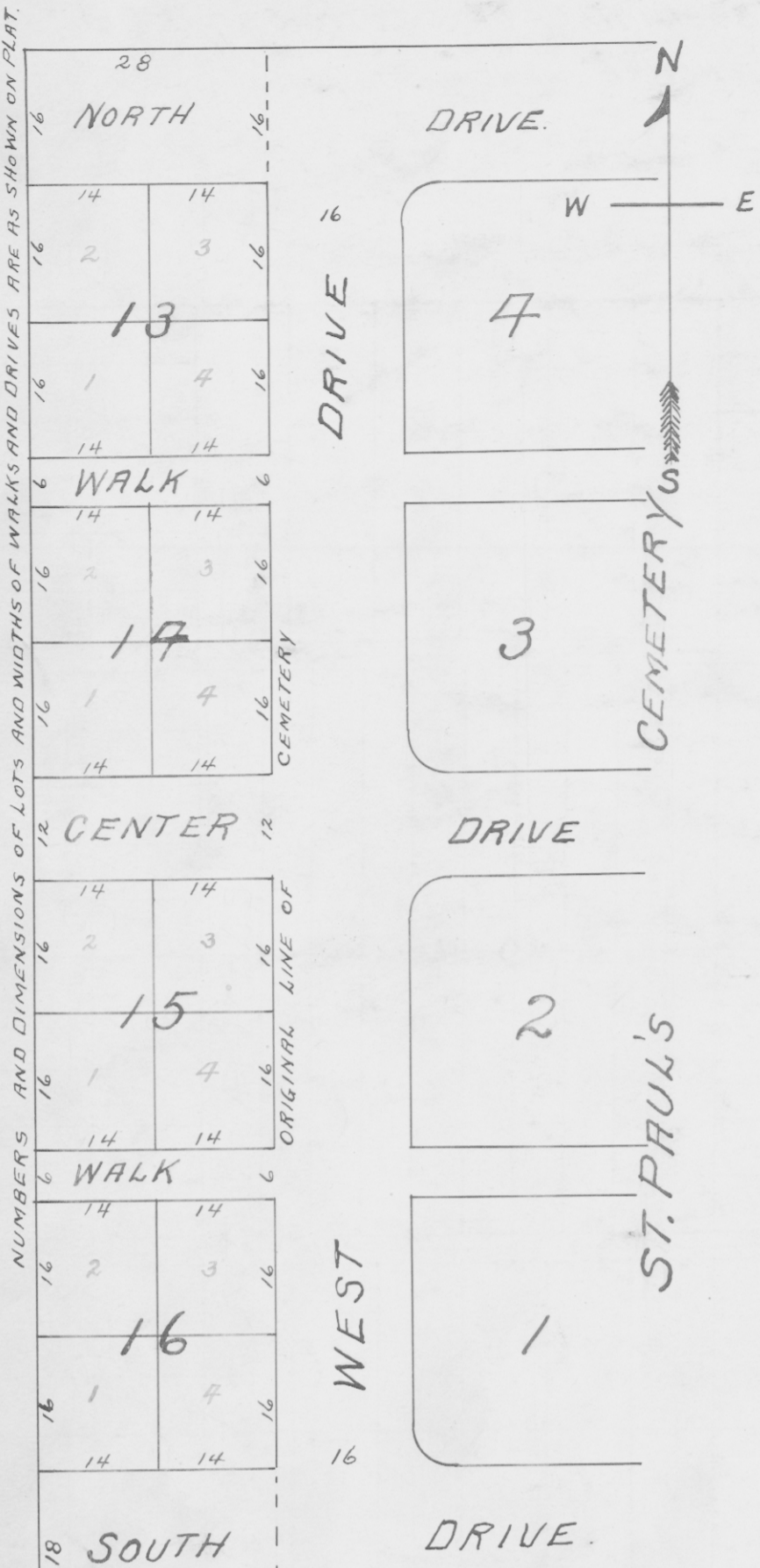
