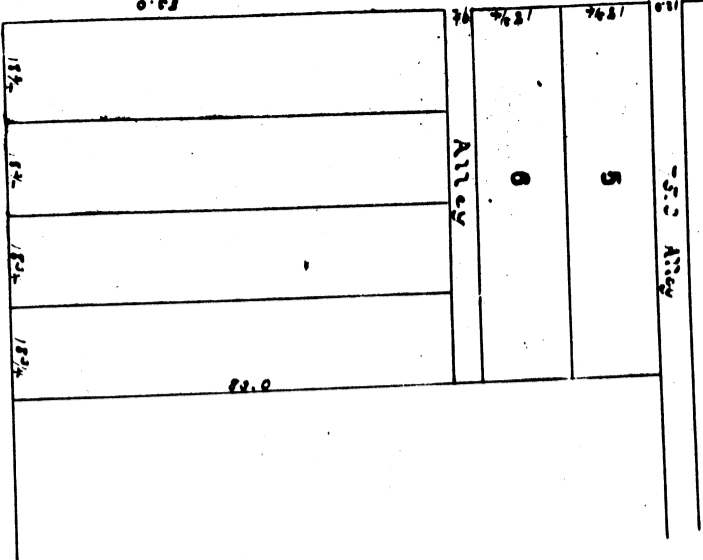


PLAN of

SUBDIVISION of 196 DONATION ENL. by HALLOCK & STODDARD.



Plat of the Subdivision of Lot 196 (one hundred and Ninety six in the Br. nation Surveyment of the City of Evansville Indiana) laid out by Hallock and Stoddard and bounded as follows, commencing at the corner of Walnut Street and Market Place running thence along Market Street 130 ft. to the Alley thence on the Alley 75 feet, to the line dividing Lts. 196 & 195 thence parallel with Walnut Street to Market Place 130 feet. Thence along Market Place to the place of beginning. The lots are 18 ft. front on Market Place running back 83 feet to a division Alley the

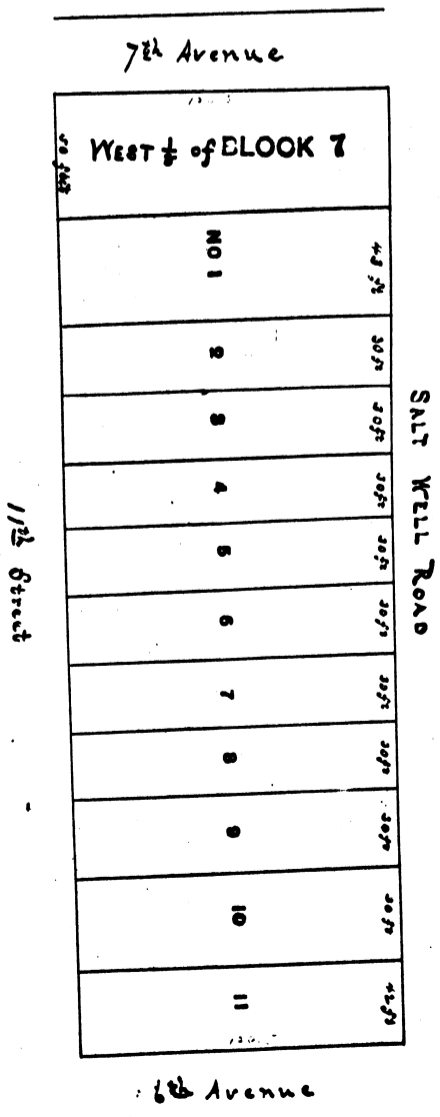
same width, and are numbered from 1 to 4 inclusive and other lots are 18 ft. front on Market Street and running back 75 feet to the dividing line of Lot 195. The same middle and are numbered from 5 to 6 as will appear by Reference to the Plat.

PLAT of BLOCK No. 7 in LAMASCO 7/8th

The following is a subdivision of the east 7/8<sup>th</sup> of Block Number Seven in Lamasco City as Platted, by Nathaniel Albertson. The said Block is divided into (11) lots. Lots No One (1) is 43 feet, and Lot Seven (7) is (42) feet front, each the balance are thirty feet each, extending from the North leading to the Salt Well, or north line of said Block to the Street. It is recorded according to recorded Plat of said Lamasco City as recorded at page 372 of the Book Records of Vanderburgh County Indiana. Nathaniel Albertson.
