Town of Evansville: A map of a piece of land in the N.W. quarter of Section No 37 in Township No 6 S. R. 10 W. containing 34 acres 2 Rods and 35 Rods as subdivided into lots, alleys and streets, in November 1836 for Frederick E. Goodsell.

Remarks.

40 feet is laid off on west side for a half street.
40 feet do do on south side do do
61 1/2 feet " " on north side " " and a narrow strip
of 10 feet is left on the East side. Avenues and streets are 80 feet.
East and West Alleys are 12 feet. North and South Alleys are 20 feet.
Lots are 100 feet long and 25 ft. wide. The whole work is laid off parallel to and perpendicular from the section lines which bound the North and West sides of the piece.

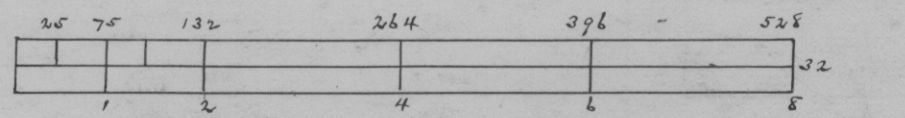

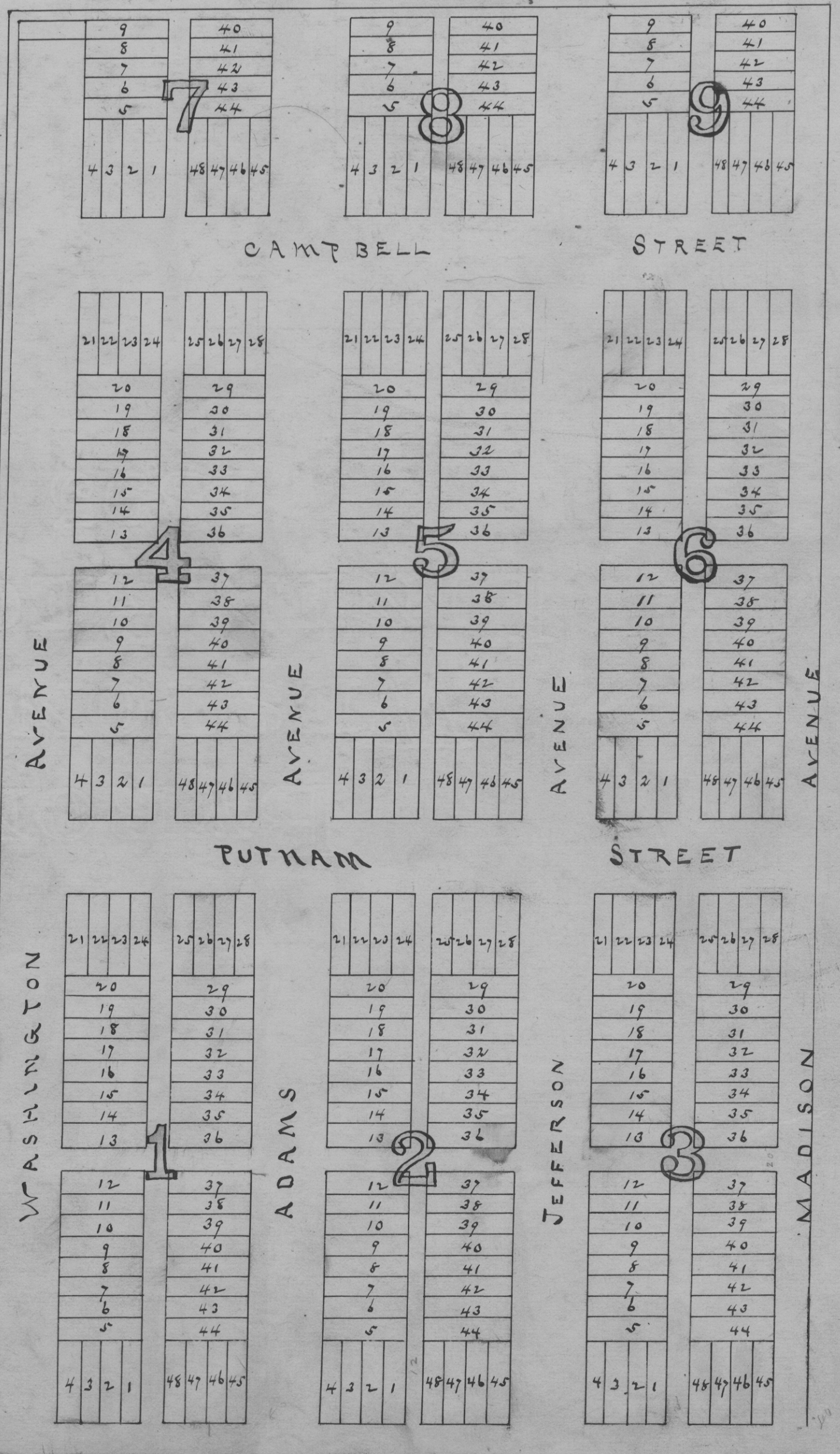
