

GROSSMAN GARDENS NO. 3

LEGAL DESCRIPTION

Part of the North half of the Northwest Quarter of Section 31, Township 6 South, Range 11 West, bound and described as follows:

Beginning at a point, said point being located by measuring from the Southeast Corner of the North half of the Northwest Quarter of said section, along and upon the South line of the North half of the Northwest Quarter of said section with a bearing of $S 87^{\circ} 4' 30'' W$ a distance of 1,367.83 feet to a point, thence measuring with a bearing of $N 0^{\circ} 51' W$ along and upon the West line of McDowell Road a distance of 249.26 feet to the place of beginning of subject boundary description, thence from said beginning point, measuring $N 0^{\circ} 51' W$ along the West line of McDowell Road, 50 feet to a point, thence measuring $S 87^{\circ} 7' W$ 247.81 feet to a point, thence measuring $N 0^{\circ} 51' W$ 458.57 feet to a point on the Southeastly right-of-way line of Indiana State Highway 62, thence measuring $S 47^{\circ} 27' W$ along the Southeastly right-of-way line of Indiana State Highway 62, 130.88 feet to a point, thence measuring $S 45^{\circ} 24' W$ 37.63 feet along the Southeastly right-of-way line of said highway to a point, thence measuring $S 37^{\circ} 50' W$ along the Southeastly right-of-way line of said highway 461.45 feet to a point, thence measuring $S 30^{\circ} 30' W$ along the Southeastly right-of-way line of said highway 358.86 feet to a point, thence $N 87^{\circ} 4' 30'' E$, 600.94 feet to a point, thence measuring $N 0^{\circ} 51' W$ 249.42 feet to a point, thence measuring $N 87^{\circ} 7' E$ 247.81 feet to the place of beginning, containing 6.07 acres more or less.

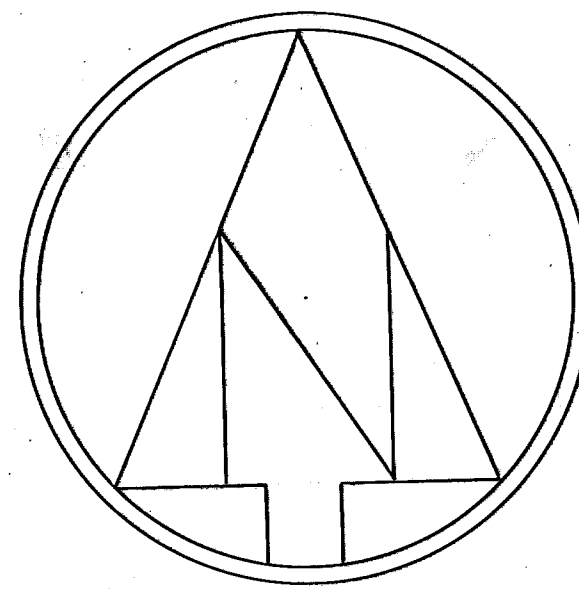

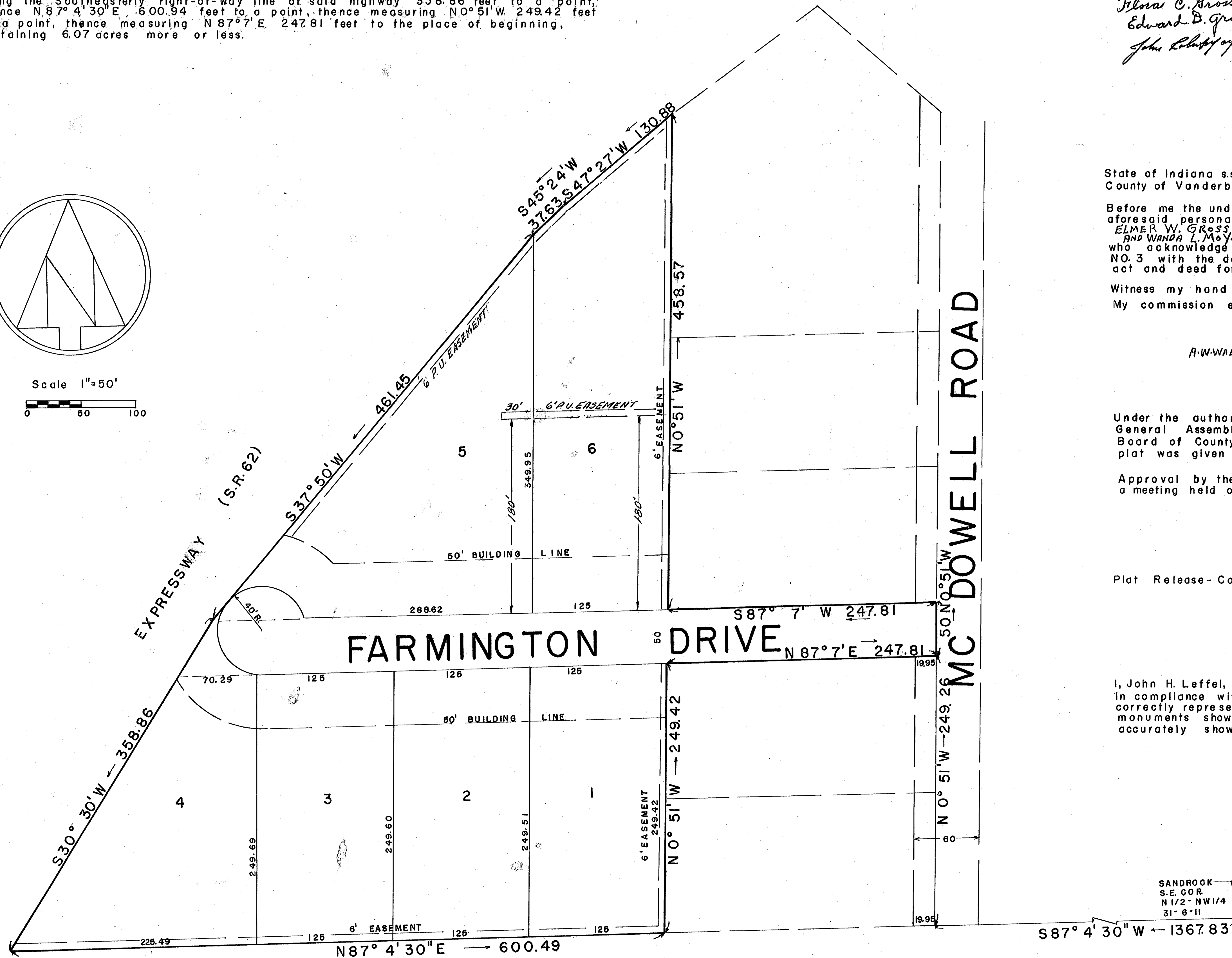
State of Indiana
