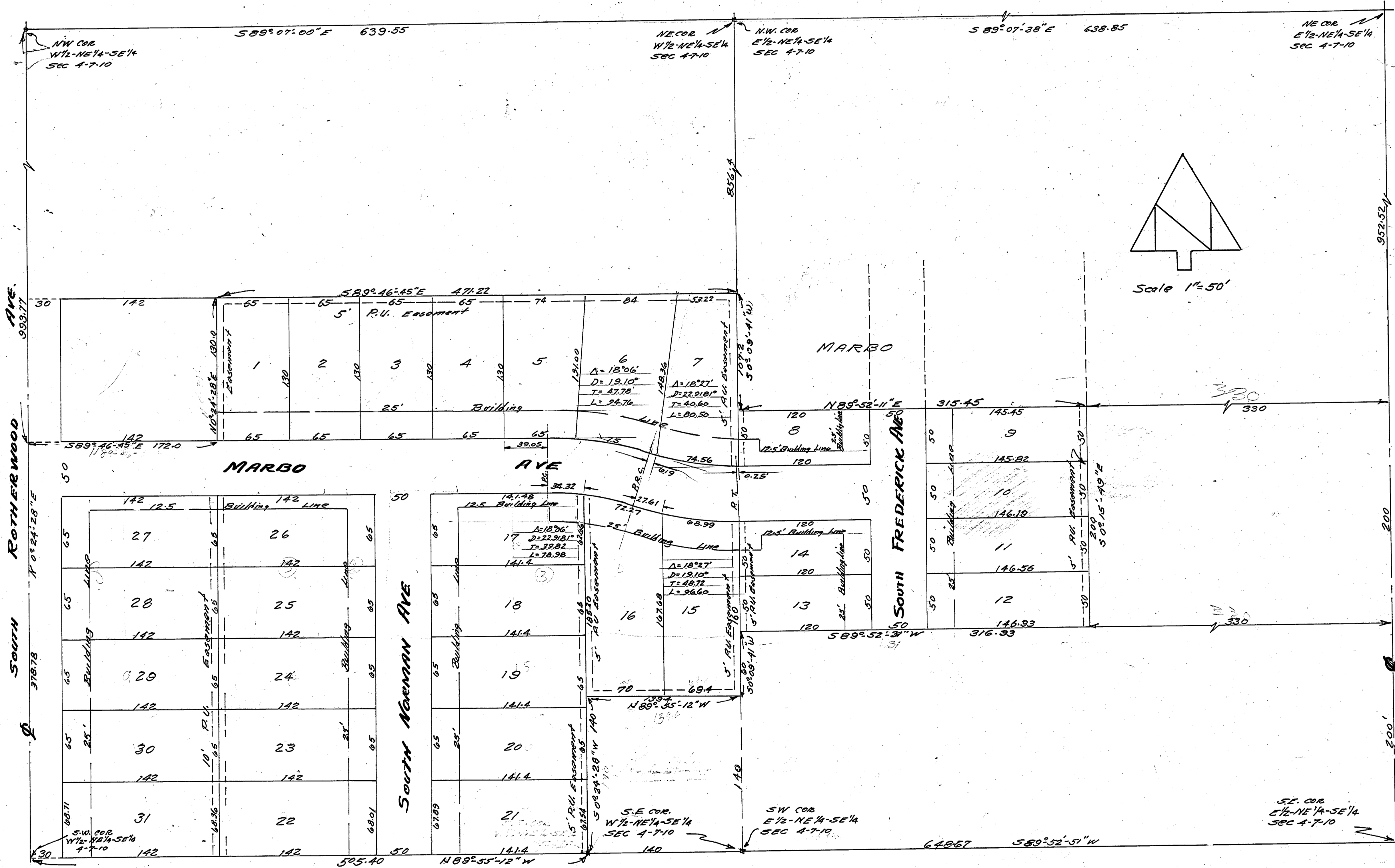

A subdivision of part of the Southeast quarter of Section 4, Township 7 South, Range 10 West described as follows: Beginning at the southwest corner of the West half of the Northeast quarter of the Southeast quarter of said section; thence $N 0^{\circ} 24' 28'' E$ along the West line of said half-quarter-quarter section for 378.78 feet to a point which is $S 0^{\circ} 24' 28'' W$ a distance of 993.77 feet from the Northwest corner thereof; thence $S 89^{\circ} 46' 45'' E$ for a distance of 172.0 feet; thence $N 0^{\circ} 24' 28'' E$ for 130.0 feet; thence $S 89^{\circ} 46' 45'' E$ for 471.22 feet to a point on the East line of said half-quarter-quarter section which is $S 0^{\circ} 09' 41'' W$ a distance 856.4 feet from the Northeast corner thereof; thence $S 0^{\circ} 09' 41'' W$ along said East line for 102.2 feet; thence $N 89^{\circ} 52' 11'' E$ for 315.45 feet to a point which is $S 89^{\circ} 52' 11'' W$ a distance of 330.0 feet from the East line of the East half of the Northeast quarter of the Southeast quarter of said section; thence $S 0^{\circ} 15' 49'' E$ and parallel to the East line of the East half of the Northeast quarter of the Southeast quarter of said section for 200.0 feet; thence $S 89^{\circ} 52' 11'' W$ for 316.93 feet to a point in the West line of the East half of the Northeast quarter of the Southeast quarter of said section which is $N 0^{\circ} 09' 41'' E$ a distance of 200.0 feet from the South line of said half-quarter-quarter section; thence $S 0^{\circ} 09' 41'' W$ along the said West line for 60.0 feet; thence $N 88^{\circ} 55' 12'' W$ and parallel to the South line of the West half of the Northeast quarter of the Southeast quarter of said section for 139.4 feet; and parallel to the South line of the West half of the Northeast quarter of the Southeast quarter of said section for 140.0 feet to a point in the South line of the West half of the Northeast quarter of the Southeast quarter of said section which is $N 89^{\circ} 55' 12'' W$ a distance of 140.0 feet from the southeast corner of said West half; thence $N 89^{\circ} 55' 12'' W$ along the South line of said West half for 305.4 feet to the place of beginning.
