

PLAT OF

Eighty-two acre and 1/40 of land lying in the south west quarter of Section Eight in Township Six South of Range Two West in the district of Colorado subject to select Minnesota Indian comprising the principal part of the east half of said quarter and a small part of the north half. Beginning at the south east corner of said quarter section running thence North 6° west 840.50 chains to the north east corner of said quarter. Thence S 74° W 20 chains. Thence S 6° E. 2.24 chains to the north side of the state road thence S. 61° E. 379 chains along the north side of said road thence N 84° 10' E. 2072 chains to the place of beginning. The plat represents the division of said tract into sixteen parts or parcels designated by the numbers from 1 to 15. All the corners are given from the Magnetic Meridian.

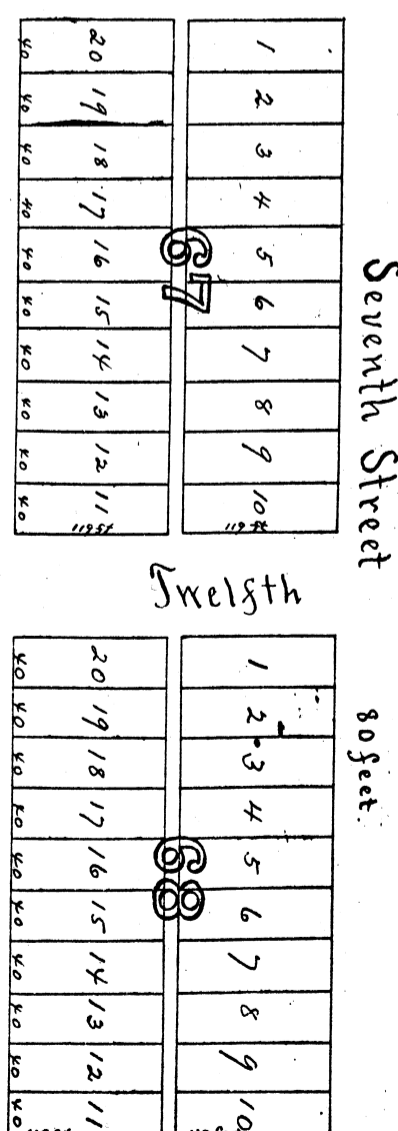
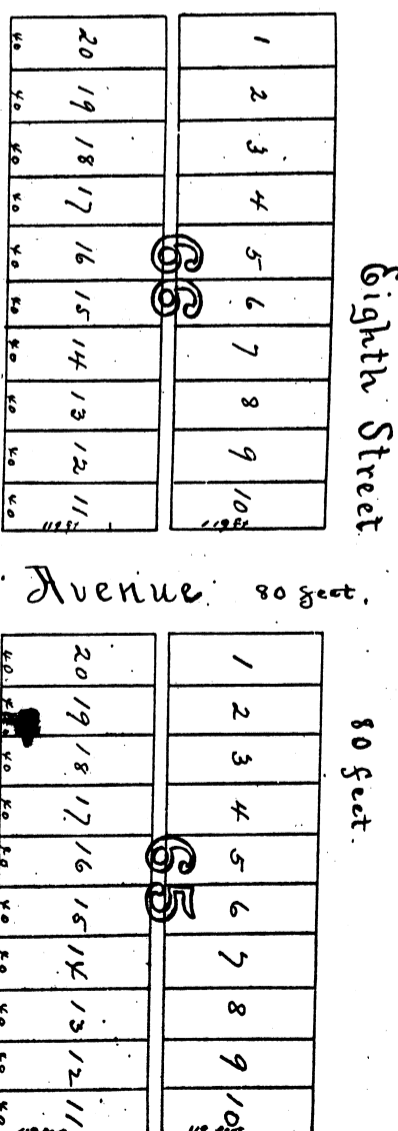

BURNS & SORENSONS SUBDIVISION, OF BLOCKS 65 66 67 & 68 LAMASCO



The above named blocks numbered six five - six six - six seven - and six eight according to the original recorded plat of said Lamascos City in the County of Henderson, state of Indiana, are hereby subdivided as shown by the above plan, that is to say, each of the said blocks is divided into twenty lots of equal size to wit: forty feet front on the respective streets adjoining by said streets and blocks, by a depth of one hundred and nineteen feet, equally divided between the roads running from east to west through each of said blocks.
