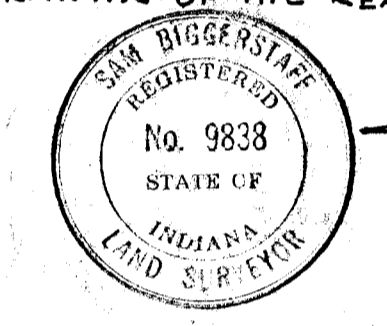
BURCH INDUSTRIAL CENTER
