

4. No business structure of any kind may be erected nor shall any business either mercantile or manufacturing be carried on within the bounds of this plat.

5. All lots shall be kept clean.

6. No lot or improvement in this addition shall ever be sold, leased, or rented to or contracted for in any way to a negro or negroes, nor shall ever be occupied by them, except those being domestic servants employed thereon or therein.

7. The foregoing limitations and restrictions shall operate in favor of each and all persons who shall from time to time respectively be the owner or owners of any lot or parcel of land in Lincolnshire No. 2 and may be enforced by one or more of such parties by injunction or other proceedings in the event of a violation or attempted violation of any one of such limitations and restrictions of any part thereof by any person.
